Provide care in the home for people needing health services, but not hospitalization




HOME CARE AGENCIES

Services provided include:

- Nursing / CNA / PCA
- Physical therapy
- Occupational therapy
- Speech therapy
- Social services
- Nutritional and food services
- Respiratory therapy
- Homemaker services



- Displays chain of command
- Shows lines of authority
- Identifies health care worker's position
- Identifies immediate supervisor



Governing body = (Board of Directors)

- Responsible for provision of safe and adequate care at a reasonable cost
- Makes facility policies
- Delegates management to an administrator

Department heads

- Have specific areas of responsibilities
- Supervise department staff
 - Finance
 - Ancillary services
 - Nursing



Medical Director

Supervises medical staff activities

- Physicians
- Residents
- Interns



Director of Nursing and Assistant DON

- Supervises nursing staff activities
- Responsible for safe nursing care
- Registered nurses




Nursing supervisor
